- A) Highest Population Density: SPSR Nellore
- B) Lowest Urbanisation: Alluri Sitarama Raju
- C) Highest Sex Ratio: Polavaram (1,051)

Answer: C

Explanation: Polavaram has the highest sex ratio (1,051). *Corrections:* Highest Population Density is Visakhapatnam (1,870); Lowest Urbanisation is Polavaram (2.84%); Lowest Literacy is Alluri Sitarama Raju (44.67%).

3. Regarding the land utilisation pattern in Andhra Pradesh, which category constitutes the largest share of the state's geographical area?

- A) Forests (22.63%)
- B) Net Area Sown (36.29%)
- C) Current Fallow Land (14.60%)
- D) Non-Agricultural Uses (12.89%)

Answer: B

Explanation: Net Area Sown is the largest land use category in the state, accounting for 59.14 lakh hectares or 36.29% of the total area.

2. Within the Agriculture sector, Horticulture recorded the highest growth rate.

Answer: A

Explanation: Statement 3 is *incorrect*. AP is the *2nd* largest producer of raw silk in India, not the 1st. Statements 1 and 2 are correct.

10. The Visakhapatnam–Chennai Industrial Corridor (VCIC) is a major infrastructure initiative in Andhra Pradesh. It is supported by financial assistance from which of the following institutions?

Answer: B

Answer: B
